PAYMENT INFORMATION

To secure your registration, please enclose a non-refundable \$150 deposit for each week registered. Subsequent payments can be made by post-dated cheques or by credit card. All fees are due by April 1, 2011. After April 1, all registrations includes full payment. **Payment plans are available; please call the Office.** Camp Mini-Yo-We accepts Visa, MasterCard, cheques, money orders or cash. Cheques are to be made payable to Camp Mini-Yo-We. Please include your child's name and Camp Session on each cheque.

DISCOUNT INFORMATION

In order to qualify for these early sign-up discounts, your full payment must be received by February 28, 2011.

Fees are due April 1, 2011 when you do not receive a discount. Please note: we do not 'double discount'. Operations Discounts will replace any previous Early Sign-up Discount or Sibling Discount.

EXTRA SERVICES AVAILABLE

Bus Service - To Camp: Sunday morning pick-up at the Yorkdale Shopping Centre (parking lot near The Bay) is 11:30am. Pick-up at the Cookstown Hwy 400 McDonald's is 12:15pm.

From Camp: Saturday morning drop-off at Cookstown Hwy 400 McDonald's is 11:30am. Drop-off at Yorkdale Shopping Centre (Parking lot near The Bay) is 12:15pm. The cost is \$42.00 plus tax per rider each way. You can register for the bus at www.miniyowe.com or indicate bus stop on your Registration Form.

Tuck Shop Accounts - There is a large variety of items offered at our Tuck Shop and we encourage you to take a look when you drop-off or pick-up your child. You can open a Tuck Account on the day your child arrives at Camp.

Weekend Program - If your child is registered for two consecutive Camp Sessions, and you are unable to pick them up between sessions, they can be registered in our Weekend Program at no extra charge. This program is not available for Junior Campers or after week 7.

Laundry Service - If your child is registered for two consecutive Camp Sessions and you would like their clothes to be washed, we offer services provided by a local Laundry Company. You will pay \$25.00 and receive a laundry bag, which you get to keep. This bag will be picked up by the Laundry Company. Your child's clothing will be washed, dried, folded and returned the following day. Special treatment is not available for delicate clothes. Camp Mini-Yo-We is NOT responsible for any lost or stolen items.

CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

1. **Custody and Disclosure** The parent(s) or guardian(s) submitting this registration are those having legal custody of the child. Conditions of custody, if applicable, must be fully communicated in writing to Camp Mini-Yo-We, including, if applicable, a photocopied section of any court order referring to visitation rights. The parent(s)/guardian(s) certifies that any and all physical, medical, emotional, mental or behavioural weaknesses or issues are fully disclosed with the registration. Failure to disclose weaknesses or issues at the time of registration could result in dismissal. The signature on the registration form signifies that both parents/guardians are in agreement with the conditions of enrolment. I give permission for my child to leave the camp property for overnight camping trips and other excursions that may occur offsite.

2. **Refunds** The deposit of \$150 per week is non-refundable for cancellations made after May 1. For cancellation prior to May 1, there is a \$50 cancellation fee. No refund will be made for dismissals due to disciplinary action or for late arrivals or early departures. In case of withdrawal from Camp Mini-Yo-We on a physician's order or for campers found with lice upon check-in, two-thirds of the fee for the remaining term will be refunded. Programs that do not receive a minimum number of registrations will be cancelled and fees paid will be fully refunded.

3. **Medical Treatment** The parent(s)/guardian(s) gives permission for the Camp Nurse to administer any non-prescription drugs to the camper in the recommended dosage as may be reasonably required. Any prescription drugs required by the camper should be brought in sufficient quantities as required for the duration of the camper's stay and may be deposited with the Camp Nurse upon arrival, who will administer them according to the appropriate schedule. In case of surgical emergency, the parent(s)/guardian(s) gives permission to the physician selected by the Camp Director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and to order injection, anaesthesia or surgery for the camper. Each camper must be covered by provincial health insurance or equivalent medical insurance. In the event that a camper requires special medication, x-ray or treatment beyond that which is available at Camp, the parent(s)/guardian(s) will be notified promptly and will be charged the additional expense of transportation and special care. Camp Mini-Yo-We requires that campers who have potentially life-threatening conditions, such as bee stings or peanut allergies, be able to manage their exposure to those substances, provide two sets of medication, be familiar with its use, and carry the medication in a fanny pack that is with them at all times.

4. **Liability** Care is taken for the safety and good health of campers, but in the event of accident, injury or sickness while the camper is the care of Camp Mini-Yo-We, Camp Mini-Yo-We Inc., including the board of directors, staff, owners and the employees of off-site facilities, are hereby released from any liability. Camp Mini-Yo-We is not responsible for damage to or loss of personal property.

5. **Dismissal** The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper who is in his/her opinion a hazard to the safety and rights of others, or who appears to him/her to have rejected the reasonable rules and controls of Camp Mini-Yo-We.

6. **Privacy** Camp Mini-Yo-We Inc. has permission to use any image or likeness or recording of the camper for promotional purposes. The information on the registration form will only be used by Camp Mini-Yo-We to provide the camp experience for which you have registered, respond to your needs and to make you aware of opportunities at Camp Mini-Yo-We.
