General Information

Camp Sessions

When choosing the session, please consider carefully whether you will be available for those dates. Once you have been accepted, we rely upon your full commitment.

Children

If you have children accompanying you when you come to serve at camp, it is your responsibility to ensure that they are registered in one of our programs.

1. Camper age children (5-16 years old) must be registered as a camper, in the appropriate program.
2. Our Grasshopper* program is for toilet trained children up to age 4.

*Operations Staff with Grasshopper-aged children will not be permitted to help at the Northwoods site, due to its topography, waterfronts and program area.

Please Note: When your children are in our camp programs, **we ask that you do not visit** with them; this causes a disruption to the program and may even cause homesickness for them or other campers.

Operations Staff Discounts

To thank you for being a part of our Operations Staff, we will apply an 'Operations Discount' per child, per week, to their camp fees. *We do not give multiple discounts, so the Operations Discount will replace any other discount of lesser value.* (i.e. early sign-up discount). Operations Discounts will only be applied when all documentation is received and verified. This includes your application and police checks for new applicants. **This year, if we have received all your information before December 31, 2011, the discount for each child will be \$215.00. After January 1, 2012, the discount for each child will be \$175.00.**

Abuse Prevention

Camp Mini-Yo-We is entrusted with the care of many children each summer and we are committed to providing a safe environment. We take the hiring of our staff very seriously - **Police Checks are required** for all new applicants and for returning staff, after every three years. We pay the fee when you use the Back Check Process!!!

Conditions of Serving at Camp Mini-Yo-We

Please read the following conditions carefully. If you accept these conditions and are willing to be subject to the rules governing Camp Mini-Yo-We, please sign the appropriate part of your application.

Dismissal - The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a staff member who in his/her opinion is a hazard to the safety and the rights of others or who appears to him/her to have rejected the policies, procedures and rules of camp.

Health Coverage - Precautions are taken for the safety and good health of our staff, but in the event of accident or sickness, Camp Mini-Yo-We Incorporated, including the Camp Directors and their staff, and the employees of facilities outside of the camp ground, are hereby released from any liability. Each staff member must be covered by Provincial Health Insurance or equivalent private medical insurance.

Medical Emergency - In case of medical emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the Camp Director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for and to order injection, anesthesia or surgery for the staff member as named in the application.

Additional Medical Expenses - In the event that a staff member requires special medication, diagnosis or treatment beyond that which is possible at the camp, family members will be notified and will be charged with the additional expense of transportation and special care.

Publicity - I give permission for Camp Mini-Yo-We to use any photograph or video of my image for promotional use. I also give permission for my name and address to be distributed on a staff mailing list.

Declaration of Acceptance - I have read and understand the Camp Mini-Yo-We Mission and Statement of Faith and will conduct myself in keeping with the beliefs set out therein.

Mission and Statement of Faith

Our mission is to reach and disciple young people for Jesus Christ through excellence in camping and retreat programs.

A. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons; Father, Son, and Holy. (Duet. 6:4; Neh. 9:6 Matt. 28:19; John 14:16-17; 1 Cor. 13:14; Eph. 2:13-18)

B. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His substitutionary and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the righthand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory. (Matt. 1:23; John 1:1-2; John 1:14-18; Rom. 3:24-25; 1 Peter 2:21-24; 1 John 2:1-2; Rev. 3:10)

C. We believe all human beings are created in the image of God, but through sin of the first man Adam, separation from God has passed to the entire human race. Therefore all now have a sinful nature. We further believe that sin and its penalty of physical and spiritual death has passed on to the entire human race and therefore, all people are subject to eternal judgment and cannot save themselves. (Gen. 1:27; Isa 53:6; Acts 17:24-28; Rom. 3:10-12. 23; Rom. 5:12-19; Eph. 4:18-32)

D. We believe in the inspiration of all Scriptures, originally given by God, that they are inerrant and the final authority of faith and life. (Luke 4:4; 1 Thess. 2:13; 2 Tim. 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21)

E. We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential. Salvation is a gift of grace from God, which man cannot earn through works, but only through faith in Jesus Christ. (John 3:3-21; Rom 3:24-25; Rom 4:1-9 Eph 1:1-7; Titus 2:11-14; 1 Peter 2:24; 1 John 5:11-13; Eph. 2:8-9)

F. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by Whose indwelling, the Christian is enabled to live a godly life. (1 John 3:5; John 14:26; John 16:7-14; Acts 1:5-8; Acts 4:8, 31; Rom 8:9,14,23; Rom 15:16; 1 Cor 6:19, 20; Gal. 5:6)

G. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (Luke 16:19-26; John 5:28-29; John 11:15-16; John 14:2-3; 1 Thess 4:16- 17; 2 Thess. 1:7-9; Rev. 20:11-15)

H. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ, who is the head of the church. (Rom 12:5; Eph. 4:3-10; 1 Cor. 12:12-17; Col. 2:19)

I. We believe there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus (1 Tim 2:5; Heb. 8:6; Heb.12:24)
