Packing List

When packing, please consider that each cabin has limited space to store items. Please pack as conservatively as possible and label items to help with lost and found.

CLOTHING

- Modest Bathing Suits (x2)
- Underwear
- Socks
- Modest Shirts/Tops (several)
- Modest Shorts (several)
- Sweatshirts / Sweaters
- Jeans
- Rain Gear (jacket, boots, etc.)
- Old Clothes (for messy activities)

GEAR

- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Towels (beach + shower)
- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Sun Screen
- Insect Repellent
- Journal / Writing Paper & Pen
- Camera (optional)
- Bible

DO NOT BRING

- ✗ iPods, MP3 Players, etc.
- ✗ Jewelry & Valuables
- ✗ Weapons (ex. Knives)
- ✗ Alcohol, Lighters, Matches, etc.

CELL PHONE POLICY

LITs are permitted to bring cell phones but they will be kept by their leaders during the duration of the program. LITs can use their phones during their days off at the director's discretion.

CAMP DRESS CODE

The following dress code has been established to help young leaders grow in maturity. With LIT being a co-ed program it is especially important for participants to adhere to Camp's dress expectations.

GIRLS

1. Tank/Halter tops are allowed as long as no bra straps, midriff or cleavage is showing. No crop tops. If you aren't sure please don't bring it.
2. Swimsuits must be one-piece or tankinis where the top touches the bottom. You may be asked to cover up with a dark t-shirt if swim wear is inappropriate.
3. Shorts/skirts need to reach to the tip of your middle finger when arms are at your side.
4. T-shirts with inappropriate language, gestures or advertising are not permitted.

GUYS

1. Underwear should not be visible and should remain underneath your shorts or pants.
2. Swimsuits must fit well enough to stay up both when dry or wet. Speedos are not permitted.
